Special Request: As part of the 175th Anniversary Celebrations, the Diocese of Antigonish is endeavouring to create a quilt which will be composed of fabric squares from all of the parishes in the diocese. Each pastor has been provided a piece of fabric, measuring 8 x 8 inches, which can be stitched, embroidered or painted with an image symbolic of our parish community.
