Cemetery Day: Spring Tune-up: Due to the weather not co-operating, we re-scheduled the cemetery clean-up to **Saturday, July 6th**, beginning at **8:30 am**. This will include grave levelling, and spreading of topsoil and grass seed to improve the overall appearance of the cemetery. Many volunteers are required. Please bring rakes, shovels, spreaders, and wheel barrows, etc.. Thank you very much.

Rosary after Mass: We will be praying the rosary together after the **5 pm mass on Saturday, July 6th**, for the sick of the parish, and for any special intentions you may have. Please join us.

Cemetery Mass: Mass for those who are buried in St. Joseph's Cemetery will be held on **Saturday, July 20th**, at **5:00 pm**, followed by a strawberry shortcake reception at the St. Joseph's Lakeside Community Centre.

Wheelchair Accessible Door: The door at the entrance to the church lobby is designed to be wheelchair accessible. However, it is not working as it should, and parishioners are asked to use caution when opening and closing the door, making sure it does not bang shut.

Parish Council has contacted the original installer, and an inspection by one of their representatives has determined that the door mechanism that controls the opening and closing of the door is too old and not repairable. A new unit will be installed in due course.
