February 2nd and 3rd, 2020



Bishop Wayne Kirkpatrick will be installed as the 10th Bishop of the Diocese of Antigonish on Monday, February 3rd, 2020. We are all invited to welcome Bishop Kirkpatrick in prayer, and by attending the installation events: Evening Prayer service on **Sunday, February 2nd at 7 pm**, and the Installation Mass on **Monday, February 3rd at 3 pm**, followed by a reception in St. Ninian's Place.

Bishop Kirkpatrick comes to us from the Diocese of St. Catherine's, Ontario. His most recent appointment was as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Toronto, where he oversaw the care of the pastoral needs of the Northern Pastoral Region. He has also served as Episcopal Vicar for Religious institutes of men and women in the Archdiocese, and as Episcopal Vicar for the Francophone community.

Since 2014 he has been the president of St. Augustine's Seminary, as well as a Member of the Toronto School of Theology Board of Trustees. He brings with him a tremendous amount of pastoral experience serving in the parish and involvement in the administration of a diocese.
