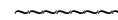
## Year of Saint Joseph

### A Message from Bishop Wayne Kirkpatrick

**My Dear People,**

Nova Scotia Premier Iain Rankin and Chief Medical Officer, Dr. Robert Strang have announced a province-wide shutdown, effective April 28<sup>th</sup>.

**The directive mandates that there be no in-person faith gatherings in the province. I support this shutdown and direct that our churches remain closed to the public until further notice. Our diocesan and parish offices will be closed to the public during this time.**

The new variants of this pandemic have been spreading rapidly. We need to work together to stop the spread of this virus by staying home and limiting our interaction with others.
